Proactive work this quarter in the Wotton-Under-Edge policing area (parishes of W-U-E, N Nibley, Kingswood, Hillesley & Alderley:

- Weekly drop in sessions at the keepers
- Multi-agency meetings and work being done regarding a homeless female.
- 2 vehicles seized for driving with no insurance.
- Joint working with social services and the Crisis team to support a resident suffering with mental health conditions.
- Successful application for a partial closure order on a property to protect a vulnerable person, regular patrols and visits to ensure it is being adhered to.
- 2 males arrested for possession of Class B drugs and drug driving.
- Evening with National Youth Service, canvassing youth out in Wotton and at the youth centre to find out what they would like from a youth provision in the area.
- Regular contact with Katherine Lady Berkeley School safeguarding team.
- Tackling anti-social behaviour within Wotton 1 Restorative Justice and a number of community resolutions
- 2 Crime prevention survey's on properties.
